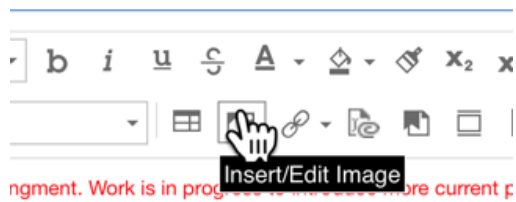


Hello,

here is what i tried:

1. On a created wiki page, select insert image:



2. Choose a local SVG file, fill the needed fields:

Insert/Edit Image

External URL: Attachment

Attachment type:  Link to an existing image attachment of this page  
 Upload a new image attachment and link to it

\*Image file: Datei auswählen AOD CDT Lab.svg

\*File name: AOD CDT Lab.svg

Description: Some description

Alternate text: Some alternate text

3. With SVG you receive the following message and cannot continue:

Select an image file

\*Image file: Datei auswählen AOD CDT Lab.svg

If alternatively i use a png file, the file is attached and the following html code is created:

If i search for the GUIDs and filenames used and attach the SVG manually to the wiki page, then adapt the html code to the SVG attachment it is shown correctly within the wiki page. It simply takes a lot of time to do this manually when i cannot see that even a real code change would be necessary to include SVG.

But I could not find any hints on the Knowledge Center that the allowed file types can be edited.
